

What is HOS?

HOS stands for Hours of Service. These are regulations issued by the FMCSA to limit the number of daily and weekly hours spent driving and working.

Why HOS Matters

HOS rules help prevent driver fatigue, improve road safety, and ensure compliance with federal laws.

Basic Rules

- 11-hour driving limit
- 14-hour on-duty limit
- 30-minute break after 8 hours
- 60/70 hour limit over 7/8 days

Required Logs

Drivers must maintain logs using an ELD (Electronic Logging Device) and retain supporting documents such as fuel receipts, bills of lading, etc.

Common Violations

- Driving beyond allowed hours
- Falsifying logs
- Missing break periods
- No supporting documents

Tips for Compliance

- Plan your trips ahead
- Take timely breaks
- Use ELDs properly
- Audit your logs regularly
